


Cherry trees along the Kinkai Tone River, which have been awarded the Nagasaki Cityscape Award, are planted along both banks for a stretch of two kilometers. In springtime, the cherry trees in full blossom and the adjacent Yashirogaoka Flower Park's fields of canola flowers are a feast for the eyes. The Tone River is also a great place to spot fireflies, and from the end of May to early June they can be seen captivatingly dancing around the nighttime riverside.

The sea bream miso soup alone, served in a large bowl, is enough to fill you up!! Used as a canteen by those working at the fish market in the morning, from lunchtime onwards it becomes a set lunch restaurant serving meals made with love and care.

This restaurant has long been known as a place where you can enjoy fresh eel dishes. The owner uses local charcoal from Kamiura to grill the eel, keeping it alive in the local waters of Kamiura until just before cooking. The dense and aromatic "unaju" (eel over rice dish) is the most popular dish because of how filling it is. All meals are by reservation only, so you will need to contact the restaurant at least one day in advance. There is also a cozy counter and a tatami room where you can relax.

You can taste sweets and dishes made with local ingredients. Traditional dishes in Sotome (goat stew, "gane" soup, etc.) are sometimes served at events, so be sure to check it out. The vegetables are grown without the use of pesticides, so you can enjoy them with peace of mind. The cafe mainly makes "kankoromochi" (sweet potato rice cakes), so you can grill them yourself over the charcoal fire! The interior of the cafe uses the masonry that is characteristic of Shitsu district, and the hand-painted plaster makes the space very comfortable.

The restaurant is located next to the Former Shitsu Aid Center, so you can satisfy your appetite for good food and history. The restaurant contributes to the slow food movement, a movement to preserve traditional food cultures, by using a Sotome-grown citrus fruit called the "yuko". You can find dishes that use yuko on the menu.
