 This oceanside park, which was made by dividing a natural cove, offers a chance to enjoy some relaxing, soothing time with adorable bottle-nose dolphins. You can also enjoy coffee and other drinks.

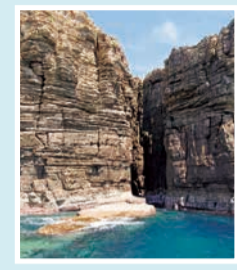
**41 Shoni Park**  
 (Iki Shrine, tomb of Shoni Suketoki, and anchor stone of the Mongol army)  
 Iki was invaded twice by Mongol (Yuan dynasty) forces: first at the Battle of Bun'ei in 1274 and again at the Battle of Kōan in 1281. Iki Shrine enshrines Shoni Suketoki, who was killed in the Battle of Kōan.



**10 Sakyobana**  
 This sea cliff stretches for about 1 kilometer. This strangely shaped rock jutting out of the ocean looks as if it consists of a bundle of narrow pillars with the unique columnar joints of basalt rock.



**3 Harahoge Jizo**  
 The name for these six Jizo statues standing in the ocean at Yahataura derives from the fact that round holes ("hoge") have been bored in their abdomens ("hara").



**1 Saruiwa**  
 This basalt rock on a sea cliff, which closely resembles a monkey facing sideways, stands 45 meters high at the tip of the Kurosaki Peninsula. Osaru-no-Kagoya, which sells Iki-related gifts and souvenirs, is located next to the parking lot.



**9 Oni-no-Ashiato**  
 This enormous hole, which has a circumference of about 110 meters, is said by locals to be the footprint of a large demon.



**11 Takenotsuji Observation Deck**  
 This platform is located atop the island's tallest peak at an elevation of 212.8 meters. The location hosted a beacon tower and lookout station, highlighting its strategically important role in Japan's defense.

**49 Tatsunoshima Jagatani**  
 This bluff was formed when waves eroded the sandstone and mudstone of the Katsumoto stratum. It stands about 50 meters tall.

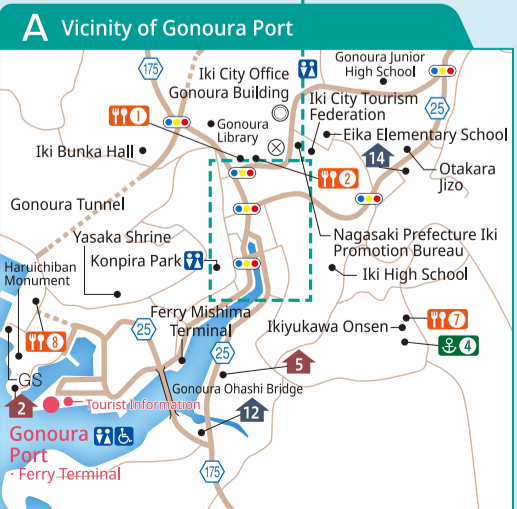

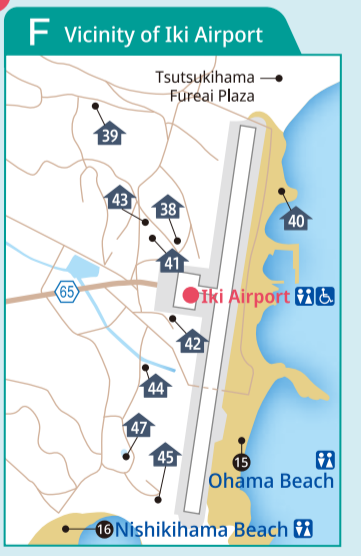
